If you have failed to file such return(s), you must file proper return(s) within 15 days after the date of this notification and pay any tax computed to be due. Your remittance of any tax computed to be due must include interest and penalties at the rates provided by law.

If you have any questions regarding this matter, please do not hesitate to call the undersigned for additional information or assistance.

If you fail to file proper return(s) within 15 days, the Commissioner may determine the tax due according to his best information and belief and will assess the same at not more than double the amount so determined, which additional tax shall be in addition to the other penalties provided by law.

In addition, criminal penalties may be imposed for, among other things, any willful attempt to evade or defeat any tax, any willful failure to collect or truthfully account for and pay over any tax, or any willful failure to file any return, as provided by General Laws, Chapter 62C, section 73, and other provisions of the General Laws.
