

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

Published in OUR highly visible Constitution, posing as Fundamental Law,

beginning with the 13th Amendment,

the Legislative Defendants enacted multiple Amendments

containing these or similar words:

***The Congress shall have power** to enforce, by appropriate legislation,
the provisions of this article.”*

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

Self-evident in their own words:

(a) "shall have " is an admission of not-presently-granted authority,
otherwise the phrase is pointless.

(b) "*the provisions of this article*", unless pointlessly redundant,
must not currently be contained in OUR Constitution;
thereby **forbidden by non-expansion** to be added
(OUR Const; Art 1, Sec 8, Cl 18; 9th and 10th Amend);
thereby irrelevant; thereby also pointless.

(c) "shall have power" is synonymous with "will create power";
thereby a self-evident Breach of OUR Constitution's non-expansion mandates
(OUR Const; Art 1, Sec 8, Cl 18; 9th and 10th Amend).

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

In the 13th Amendment, Congress recognized their authority deficit and obtained approval through Presidential concurrence.

This is the only Amendment to engage additional approval.

This Amendment broadcast **a subversive precedent;**

thereby mishandling a serious injustice and causing more harm:

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

(a) Their illicit power phrase served no good.

Congress already possessed the authority to negate inequality errors

in OUR original Constitution's wording, such as slavery,

by reference to OUR Fundamental self-evident "truths"

("All Men are created equal")

and OUR Constitution's Preamble (Government's primary assignment).

(b) Ratification by Presidential concurrence also breaches non-expansion.

"We, the People", the Sovereigns in OUR Republic,

mandate what "Congress shall have power to" do,

not anyone in Government.

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

(c) The clause “*Congress shall have power to ...*” is highly visible.

Resolving one problem, this Amendment’s **illicit precedent**
opened a floodgate to massive abuse.

Self-evident in

the 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 18th, 19th, 23rd, 24th, and 26th Amendments;

all contain this same clause.

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

Self-evident in their documented words

“Congress shall have the power”,

the Legislative Defendants knew,

in each of these Amendments, they were not delegated any authority

to do what they wanted

yet they disregarded OUR Constitution.

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

Article 1 of OUR Constitution DOES NOT GRANT to Congress
the power to grant itself more power, hence non-expansion.

Any Amendments containing any likeness to the expansive phrase

“Congress shall have power to” are **immediately null and void**

upon their ratification; they cannot be harmoniously reconciled
with OUR Constitution’s pre-existing clauses.

Their continued existence suborns disharmony and misdirection,

and disparages OUR Constitution;

thereby cultivating rampant expansion of false authority; and

thereby requiring immediate retraction from OUR Constitution for OUR protection.

Legislative Multiple Amendments' Power Subversions

“All laws which are repugnant to the Constitution are null and void.”

Marbury vs Madison 5 US 137, 174, 176

“The general rule is that an unconstitutional statute, ...

is wholly void and ineffective for any purpose;

since its unconstitutionality dates from the time of its enactment...

A void act cannot be legally consistent with a valid law. ...

No one is bound to obey an unconstitutional law

and no courts are bound to enforce it.”16 Am Jur 2d S177, late Am Jur 2d S256
